- Telecoms seek to maximize profit through the densification of 5G antennas for 'Wireless TV' and 'The Internet of Things' NOT increased cell phone coverage.
- Carriers are pushing a quick rollout of this new LARGELY UNTESTED TECHNOLOGY without adequate research of its impact on human or environmental health.
 - Studies show cell towers installed close to homes significantly reduce property values homes near cell phone towers are devalued by 20%-25%.
 - Carriers will further ERODE OUR PRIVACY / USE FACIAL RECOGNITION / SELL OUR DATA.
